Resurrection: It Was Predicted

_____ (~2200 BCE)

Had a pretty good life (1:2-3)

- 7 sons, 3 daughters
- 7,000 sheep
- 3,000 camels
- 1000 oxen
- 500 donkeys
- Lots of servants
- Greatest man among people of the East

Experiences great loss (1:13-19)

- Oxen and donkeys stolen and servants killed by Sabeans
- Sheep and servant were burned by fire from heaven
- Camels stolen and servants killed by the Chaldeans
- Children killed in a wind storm

Personally afflicted with painful sores (2:7)

In his suffering, three friends judge him without evidence to explain his suffering (3-27)

“Oh, that my words were recorded,
that they were written on a scroll,
that they were inscribed with an iron tool on lead,
or engraved in rock forever!

I know that my redeemer lives,
and that in the end he will stand on the earth.
And after my skin has been destroyed,
yet in my flesh I will see God;
I myself will see him
with my own eyes —I, and not another.
How my heart yearns within me!”
(Job 19:23-27 NIV)
