<sup>12</sup> Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts for one body, so it is with Christ <sup>18</sup> But in fact God has placed the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be. <sup>19</sup> If they were all one part, where would the body be? <sup>20</sup> As it is, there are many parts but one body <sup>22</sup> On the contrary, those parts of the body that seem to be weaker are <sup>24</sup> But God has put the body together,
