


The Persian Empire

 Also known as the Achaemenid Empire (a ruling clan of Persia) Lasted approximately from 559 B.C. to 331 B.C.



The Persian Empire

- Cyrus the Great started ruling in 559 BC
- Cyrus overthrew the Median, Lydian, and Babylonian Empires • Cyrus created an empire of many nations.

- Was tolerant of other's national religions
- Cyrus sent the exiles to rebuild Jerusalem (Ezra 1)
- Cyrus -> Cambysus II -> Darius -> Xerxes • Darius was king when Daniel went to the lion's den (Daniel 6)
