²⁴When Joseph woke up, he did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took Mary home as his wife. ²⁵But he did not consummate their marriage until she gave birth to a son. And he gave him the name Jesus.

• Jesus' deity comes from His conception through the Holy Spirit Joseph believed there was something supernatural about Mary's pregnancy Matthew specifically declared Jesus as "God with us"
