${ }^{1}$ Some time after this, Jesus crossed to the far shore of the Sea of Galilee (that is, the Sea of Tiberias), ${ }^{2}$ and a great crowd of people followed him because they saw the signs he had performed by healing the sick.

${ }^{5}$ When Jesus looked up and saw a great crowd coming toward him, he said to Philip, "Where shall we buy bread for these people to eat?" ${ }^{6} \mathrm{He}$ asked this only to test him, for he already had in mind what he was going to do.

${ }^{8}$ Another of his disciples, Andrew, Simon
Peter's brother, spoke up, ${ }^{9}$ "Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish, but how far will they go among so many?"

## Relying On God's Resources

${ }^{10}$ Jesus said, "Have the people sit down."
There was plenty of grass in that place, and they sat down (about five thousand men were there). ${ }^{11}$ Jesus then took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed to those who were seated as much as they wanted. He did the same with the fish.

## Relying On God's Resources

${ }^{12}$ When they had all had enough to eat, he said to his disciples, "Gather the pieces that are left over. Let nothing be wasted." ${ }^{13}$ So they gathered them and filled twelve baskets with the pieces of the five barley loaves left over by those who had eaten.

## Relying On God's Resources

${ }^{14}$ After the people saw the sign Jesus performed, they began to say, "Surely this is the Prophet who is to come into the world." ${ }^{15}$ Jesus, knowing that they intended to come and make him king by force, withdrew again to a mountain by himself.
