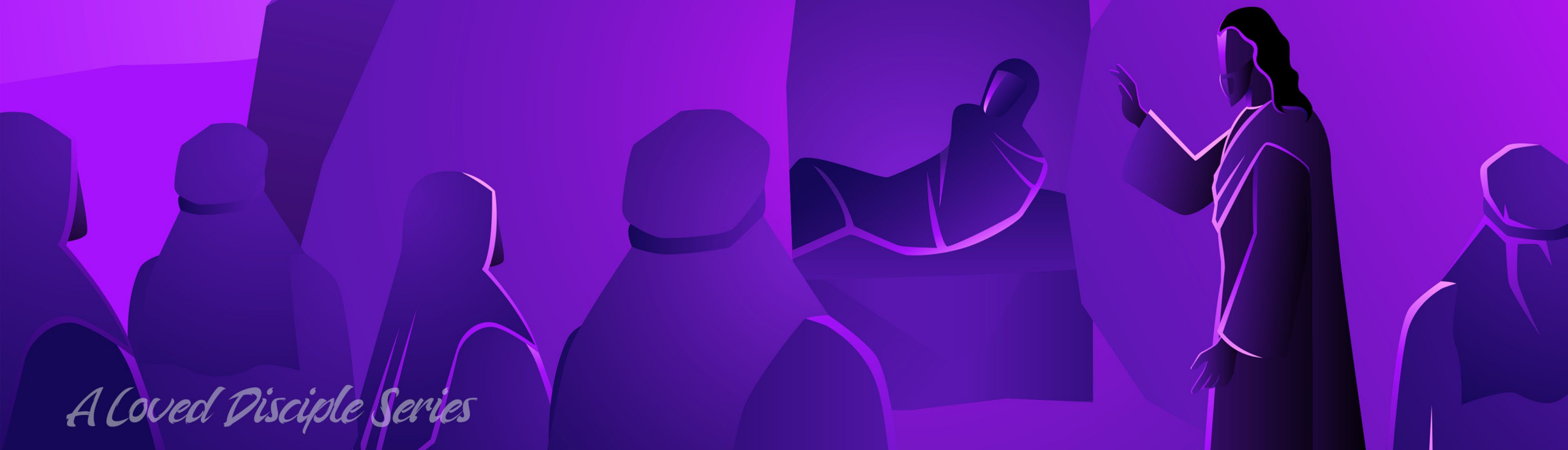
Death Is Defeated
