Imitate God

(Luke 1:26-38 NIV)

Jealousy (Of)

They angered him with their high places; they aroused his jealousy with their idols. (Psalms 78:58 NIV)

I am jealous for you with a godly jealousy. I promised you to one husband, to Christ, so that I might present you as a pure virgin to him. (2 Corinthians 11:2 NIV)

Perfection (_____)

"As for God, his way is perfect." (2 Samuel 22:31 NIV)

Not that I have already grasped it all or have already become perfect, but I press on if I may also take hold of that for which I was even taken hold of by Christ Jesus. (Philippians 3:12 NIV)

Truthfulness ()

For the word of the LORD is right and true; he is faithful in all he does. (Psalms 33:4 NIV)

Show me your ways, LORD, teach me your paths. Guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and my hope is in you all day long. (Psalms 25:4-5 NIV)

Goodness ()

Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne ... (Psalms 89:14 NIV)
