¹⁶So the king gave the order, and they brought Daniel and threw him into the lions' den. Theking said to Daniel, "May your God, whomyou serve continually, rescue you!"

¹⁷A stone was brought and placed over themouth of the den, and the king sealed it withhis own signet ring and with the rings of hisnobles, so that Daniel's situation might notbe changed.

¹⁸Then the king returned to his palace and spent the night without eating and withoutany entertainment being brought to him. Andhe could not sleep.

¹⁹At the first light of dawn, the king got up andhurried to the lions' den. 20 When he camenear the den, he called to Daniel in ananguished voice, "Daniel, servant of the livingGod, has your God, whom you servecontinually, been able to rescue you from the lions?"

²¹Daniel answered, "May the king live forever!²²My God sent his angel, and he shut themouths of the lions. They have not hurt me,because I was found innocent in his sight.Nor have I ever done any wrong before you,Your Majesty."

²³The king was overjoyed and gave orders tolift Daniel out of the den. And when Danielwas lifted from the den, no wound was foundon him, because he had trusted in his God.

And Consequences

²⁴At the king's command, the men who hadfalsely accused Daniel were brought in andthrown into the lions' den, along with theirwives and children. And before they reachedthe floor of the den, the lions overpoweredthem and crushed all their bones.

²⁵Then King Darius wrote to all the nationsand peoples of every language in all the earth:

"May you prosper greatly!

²⁶"I issue a decree that in every part of mykingdom people must fear and reverence the God of Daniel.

"For he is the living God and he endures forever; his kingdom will not be destroyed, his dominion will never end.

²⁷He rescues and he saves; he performs signs and wonders in the heavens and on the earth. He has rescued Daniel from the power of the lions."

²⁸So Daniel prospered during the reign of Darius and the reign of Cyrus the Persian.
